- 12mm Socket wrench (re-tighten bolts to 25-30NM) S


### **CAUTION**

### INSTALLATION PROCEDURE - Remove all headrests and loosen all webbing straps and buckles on seat covers.


# STEP 1

Start with passenger seat.

Passenger seat. Undo the elastic strap underneath the seat which holds the flap that protects the electronic wires in the seat.



Passenger seat. Pull cover over seat bottom and feed three straps through gap between backrest and seat bottom.



Passenger seat. Feel for the straps at the back of the seat, pull it to the front and around the bar on the bottom of the seat then back to the buckle at the back of the seat.



Passenger seat. Pull cover over seat backrest, feed three straps same as in step 2, pull to the front and thread through buckles on the front of the seat.



Passenger seat. Position and smooth out covers to line up with the seat and tighten straps to hold seat covers secure. Thread left and right side webbing straps on the side of the seat and attach to left and right buckles at back of squab cover.



Passenger seat. NB. Webbing strap on the door side should be fed through seat plastic and the strap on the consol side goes around the seat. Tighten all webbing buckles and smooth out fabric for a neat finish.

Driver's seat – as per Passenger's seat.



**Rear Bench**. Lift up the 60/40 rear bench seats and remove (5x) 12mm bolts to release bench from vehicle.



**Rear Bench.** Firmly lift the bench, remove from the vehicle & place in a clean area to continue with the fitment of the seat covers.




Rear bench backrest. Pull cover over the backrest and unzip the armrest section. Feed the buckles through the gap between the backrest and seat bottom.



Rear bench backrest. Feed the webbing straps down the back of the backrest and thread through buckles at the bottom. Tighten webbing straps.



**Rear bench backrest.** Pull the armrest flaps around the armrest then join Velcro on the side of cover (as displayed in picture).



Rear bench 60-seat. Lift up armrest and zip closed.



Rear bench 60-seat. Pull seat bottom cover over the 60-seat and feed buckles through gap in the middle of the backrest and seat bottom.



Rear bench 60-seat. Lift seat bottom completely, feel for the buckles on the bottom of the backrest and thread webbing straps through the buckles. Position and smooth out seat cover then tighten straps to keep cover in place.



Rear bench 60-seat. Take the one side strap through the loop at the bottom of the seat then join with the other side strap with the buckle and tighten to keep seat cover sides secure.

40-seat as per 60-seat



Headrest covers. When done fitting the seat covers replace all headrests and cover with headrests covers. Pull down for snug fit and secure cover with Velcro at the bottom.

NB. Re-bolt bench seat in vehicle (tighten)

bolts to 20-35nm).



Centre console cover. Lift up centre console.




**Centre console cover**. Pull the cover onto the centre console. Making sure lower elastic is as shown.



**Centre console cover**. Hook elastics around back corners of console. Make sure they are not twisted.



**Centre console cover**. Feed Velcro under the back of the console (between the console and the plastic hinge).



**Centre console cover**. Pull Velcro tight and fasten to the Velcro under the centre console.

# STEP 22

**Centre console cover**. Check fitment and adjust if necessary.
